2. Student materials will not be collected or distributed for ANY grade level at this time. All student materials will be packed and sent over to our temporary campus of Fyfe ES. Once we have moved over to Fyfe, we will provide more information about how we will be able to safely distribute student materials.
3. No yearbooks will be distributed at this time. The yearbooks will be distributed at Fyfe once we have moved into this campus.
4. We will not collect any Chromebooks from students at this time. These Chromebooks can be used during the summer to help students continue with their virtual studies. We will collect these Chromebooks in the fall once we have moved into Fyfe ES.
5. You will be able to pay for a yearbook you reserved once we are at Fyfe ES and the schools open back up to the public.
6. Our moving company will begin moving our materials on May 28th. The demolition of our campus will begin around June 5th.
7. Student report cards will be mailed to families from the district after the close of the school year.
8. Refunds for Lego Club will be mailed to families once when we relocate to Fyfe ES.
